Bob Matthews knows the parents and will look into what is needed, since a large amount of money has already been donated.

The next POW/MIA ceremony is April 7th and the next meeting is April 24th. Dennis Abels provided dinner for the group -- thanks Dennis. Joe Harsch will be the cook for the April meeting.
